Punishment will be awarded by the Chairman , on the basis of report submitted by Secretary after getting the explanation from/hearing the candidate and obtaining the report of invigilator / Suptd. in the case of copying.
3.	<p>(i) Tempering with his own answer book in any way.</p> <p>(ii) The candidate is found in possession of incriminating material (As described under 2(i) above and has used the material for answering the examination paper.</p> <p>(iii) Copying from the answer book of other candidate.</p>	May be debarred for appearing in any examination of Board for next two years from the date of order in addition to cancellation of the examination	
4.	<p>(i) Runs away with his own answer book.</p> <p>(ii) Refusing to give declaration in prescribed form.</p> <p>(iii) Writing of other examinee's Roll No. on answer book.</p> <p>(iv) Marking identification marks in the answer book</p>	May be debarred for appearing in any examination of Board for next three years from the date of order in addition to cancellation of the examination.

(iv) Taking help of any outside person in answering question paper. (v) Providing false information in examination application form. (vi) Attempting to influence any person connected with examination for favor. 	<p>May be debarred for appearing in any examination of Board for next five years from the date of order in addition to cancellation of the examination.</p>	<p>Punishment will be awarded by the Board on the basis of report submitted by Secretary, after getting the explanation from / hearing the candidate.</p>

(v) Attempting to put pressure on the Board/Selection Board for favor. (vi) Bringing in examination, Centre any weapon or similar objects.
